Ever wondered if you could survive if you were stuck in the bush with only a few items? If so, the Moonee Valley District Survival Camp may be for you!

Over 3 days and 2 nights, you will be taught new skills in survival and use many of your existing skills to construct shelters, purify water, make fire, obtain and cook food, navigate and learn how to improve your chance for rescue.

This camp is not for the faint hearted. You won't have a camp kitchen with lots of food on offer, nice eating shelters or tents to sleep in, or even a sleeping bag to keep you warm. You will need to work to survive.

The focus will be on Outdoor Adventurer Skills (OAS) Bushcraft Survival stream. Most of level 4 and 5 will be covered, with some 'I' statements from level 6 and 7.

Scouts need to be 13 years old and have obtained OAS Level 3 in Bushcraft to be eligible for this camp or equivalent.
